Conditions of Entry:

1. *Entries must be written in English, be the original unpublished work of the entrant and have not won a monetary prize in any competition.*
2. *Entries to be double spaced and printed on one side only of A4 paper, with 2.5cm margins.*
3. *Author's name should not appear on manuscript but on a separate cover sheet with address, telephone number, entry title and word count (short story) or line count (poetry).*
4. *If entrant is under 18 years parent's signature must also be included on entry form.*
5. *The judges' decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into. Please include SSAE for result sheet if required.*
6. *Awards are dependent on sufficient competitive entries being received.*
7. *Author's copyright remains.*
8. *Entry in this competition will be deemed to be acceptance of and agreement to the conditions set out above.*
9. *Multiple submissions are accepted. Author must pay entry fee for each submission*
10. *Author must be an Australian citizen*

11. *Maximum author's age is 22*
